5 (c) PREEMPTION OF STATE OR LOCAL LAWS OR OR-
6 DINANCES.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—The provisions of this sec-
8 tion shall supersede any provision of State or local
9 law or ordinance relating to markings, identification,
10 or sale of toy, look-alike, and imitation firearms. No
11 State or political subdivision shall—

12 (A) prohibit the sale or manufacturer of
13 any look-alike, nonfiring to or collector replica
14 of an antique firearm developed prior to 1898;
15 or

16 (B) prohibit the sale (other than prohib-
17 iting the sale to minors) of traditional B-B,
18 paint ball, or pellet-firing air guns that expel a
19 projectile through the force of air pressure

20 (2) LIMITATION.—This subsection shall not
21 apply to any provision of State or local law enacted
22 prior to January 30, 1955, or any subsequent
23 amendments enacted thereto.

24 (d) EFFECT ON OTHER LAWS.—This Act shall super-
25 sede the provisions of section 4 of the Federal Energy

- 1 Management Improvement Act of 1988 (15 U.S.C. 5001)
- 2 at such time as the Commission promulgates a final rule
- 3 pursuant to subsection (a).
