

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3403
OFFERED BY MR. INSLEE OF WASHINGTON

At the end of title I, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 103. E-911 CALLS FOR CUSTOMERS USING IP-ENABLED**
2 **VOICE AND VIDEO RELAY SERVICES.**

3 Within 3 months after the date of enactment of this
4 Act, the Federal Communications Commission shall—

5 (1) require providers of IP-enabled voice and
6 video relay services (as such term is defined in Com-
7 mission regulations (47 CFR 64.601))—

8 (A) to assign a 10 digit telephone number
9 that is under the North American Numbering
10 Plan to each of their IP-enabled voice and video
11 relay service users within 6 months after such
12 date;

13 (B) to ensure that such 10 digit telephone
14 numbers can be used to quickly and reliably
15 complete calls to the 911 and E911 networks;
16 and

17 (C) to make such numbers easily accessible
18 by and portable to any other provider of IP-en-
19 abled voice and video relay services if the user
20 so chooses; and

1 (2) establish a program to inform IP-enabled
2 voice and video relay service users of the availability
3 of, and assist such users in obtaining, such tele-
4 phone numbers.
