

AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT  
IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 1108

OFFERED BY Ms Myrick of North Carolina

On page 129, after line, 2 insert the following (and make such conforming changes as may be necessary):

“Sec. 922.

“(a) EFFECTIVE DATE

“This chapter shall not become effective until 2 years after the date of enactment of [the Family Smoking Prevention and Tobacco Control Act], in order to allow the Secretary of Health and Human Services sufficient time to carry out other priorities including: reviewing and approving new brand name and generic drugs; ensuring the safety and nutritional quality of the U.S. food supply; developing bioterrorism countermeasures; ensuring the safety of medical devices; and other essential functions of the agency.

“(b) REPORT

“Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of [the Family Smoking Prevention and Tobacco Control Act], the Institute of Medicine shall submit to the Secretary of Health and Human Services, the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions and the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate, and the Committee on Energy and Commerce and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives, a report making recommendations on what level of funding is needed by the Food and Drug Administration to perform its agency functions and responsibilities.
