The high cost of breast cancer medications, coupled with the increases in prices for all pharmaceuticals, makes it very difficult for many patients to get the medicines needed to treat this awful disease. Legislation that would help control the cost of these drugs would greatly improve the chances of survival for the over two million women living with breast cancer in the United States today.
