### Dingell Writes Signatories of Climate Change Principles Letter

Washington, DC  
- Rep. John D. Dingell (D-MI), the Chairman of the Committee on Energy and Commerce, today wrote the 152 Members of the Democratic Caucus who had signed an early October letter to Speaker Pelosi outlining broad principles for climate change legislation.

In his letter, Dingell noted that the Committee's recently released climate change discussion draft closely follows most of the principles outlined in the early October letter.

"I have asked everyone for substantive feedback because when the new Congress convenes in January 2009, I intend to move quickly, especially now that our President-elect shares our commitment to solving this problem," Dingell said in the letter. "I think you will find the discussion draft aligns with the principles and goals outlined in your letter."
