Keisler requesting information on the Administration's warrantless wiretapping program. The Energy and Commerce Committee leaders recently inquired of telecommunications companies about their involvement in the surveillance programs. However, the companies responded they are not permitted by the Administration to explain their role in the programs to Congressional leaders.
