About the Subcommittee

Jurisdiction of the Subcommittee on Commerce, Trade, and Consumer Protection broadly includes interstate and foreign commerce, regulation of commercial practices, and consumer protection. Sports-related practices, general privacy matters, motor vehicle safety, regulation of travel, tourism and time, and practices of the Federal Trade Commission and the Consumer Product Safety Commission all fall within the Subcommittee's jurisdiction.

During the 110th Congress, the House of Representatives has passed many bills that originated in the Subcommittee on Commerce, Trade and Consumer Protection. The bills establish safety standards for children's products, create tougher penalties for companies who violate product safety requirements, and create programs to promote Internet safety among children and teenagers.
