The Subcommittee on Energy and Air Quality considered, pursuant to notice, the following six Committee Prints and took the following actions:

Committee Print to promote advanced battery and plug-in hybrid technologies was forwarded favorably, amended, to the full Committee by a voice vote;

The following amendments were offered:

- Three amendments offered en bloc by Mr. Upton, #1, was adopted by a voice vote;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Rogers, #2, was adopted by a voice vote;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Rogers, #3, was adopted by a voice vote;
- An amendment offered by Ms. Baldwin, #4, was adopted by a voice vote.

Committee Print to enhance Energy Information Administration (EIA) data collection was forwarded favorably, without amendment, to the full Committee by a voice vote.

Committee Print to promote renewable fuel infrastructure was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, amended, by a yea-nay vote: 17-14.

The following amendments were offered:

- An amendment offered by Mr. Butterfield, #1, was adopted by a yea-nay vote: 17-13;
- An amendment to the Butterfield Amendment #1 offered by Mr. Barton, #1A, was defeated by a yea-nay vote: 13-17;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Rogers, #2, was adopted by voice vote;

- An amendment offered by Mr. Barton, #3, was defeated by a yea-nay vote: 14-17;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Rogers, #4, was adopted by voice vote;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Upton, #5, was withdrawn;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Barton, #6, was ruled not germane;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Shimkus, #7, was withdrawn;
- An amendment offered by Mr. Whitfield, #8, was withdrawn.
