At the end of the bill add the following new section:

Sec. 7. COMMISSION AUTHORIZED TO PRESCRIBE JUST AND REASONABLE  
CHARGES

The Federal Communications Commission may impose penalties under Section 503 of the Communications Act of 1934 not to exceed \$1,000,000 for any violation of provisions contained in, or amended by, sections 5 or 6 (or both) of this Act. Each distinct violation shall be a separate offense, and in case of continuing violation, each day shall be deemed a separate offense, except that the amount assessed for any continuing violation shall not exceed a total of \$10,000,000 for any single act or failure to act described in section 5 or 6 (or both) of this Act. .
