**AMENDMENT TO THE COMMITTEE PRINT
OFFERED BY MR. GONZALEZ OF TEXAS**

At the end of the committee print, add the following:

1 **TITLE VI—STUDY ON INTERNET**
2 **TRANSPARENCY**

3 **SEC. 601. STUDY ON INTERNET TRANSPARENCY.**

4 The Federal Communications Commission shall sub-
5 mit a report to the Committee on Energy and Commerce
6 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
7 Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate on
8 the following:

9 (1) The preferential pricing practices of the top
10 five Internet search engines by usage and the top
11 five electronic commerce sites by revenue.

12 (2) Whether each company offers a preferential
13 search status to companies that have a preexisting
14 financial relationship with the company and whether
15 that relationship is disclosed to consumers.

16 (3) What consumer information each company
17 routinely collects from its users and how that infor-
18 mation is used to the benefit of advertisers on their
19 sites and what sort of notice is provided to users
20 that such information is being collected.



1 (4) Whether each site properly discloses to con-
2 sumers special tying and other promotional relation-
3 ships it may have with other entities and whether it
4 offers special low cost rates to new upstart Internet
5 companies that seek to link to their sites.
