

David Barrett is President and Chief Executive Officer of Hearst Television Inc.

Hearst Television is regarded as one of the country's preeminent television companies, recognized for excellence in local news, distinguished community service, and competitive leadership in markets across America. Recently, two Hearst Television stations were the recipients of Edward R. Murrow National Awards for Overall Excellence: WCVB-TV, Boston (Large Market), and KCCI-TV, Des Moines (Small Market).

Barrett joined Hearst in 1984 as General Manager of the company's Baltimore radio stations, later assuming responsibility for WBAL-TV. In 1991 he relocated to New York as Vice President of Hearst, with operating oversight for the company's television and radio stations. In 2001 he was named President and Chief Executive Officer of Hearst-Argyle Television, Inc., now Hearst Television Inc (2009).

Barrett, a director of Hearst Corporation, is also a trustee of the trust established under the will of William Randolph Hearst and a director of The Hearst Foundations. He also serves on the boards of directors of the Emma L. Bowen Foundation, the Broadcasters Foundation, and the NAB's Education Foundation (NABEF). He previously served on the board of directors of the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB).

Barrett is a past Chairman of the Board of Governors for the ABC Television Affiliates Association, and the Federal Communications Commission's Media Security and Reliability Council (MSRC II).

Barrett has been the recipient of numerous industry honors. Most recently, in 2011, he received the DiGamma Kappa Distinguished Achievement Award in Broadcasting from the University of Georgia's Grady College of Journalism, which bestows the annual Peabody Awards, and the First Amendment Leadership Award from the Radio Television Digital News Foundation.
