Robert Vito is the Regional Inspector General for the Philadelphia Regional Office of Evaluation and Inspections at the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Office of Inspector General (OIG). Mr. Vito has been with the Office of Inspector General for 33 years and has served in his current position since June 1995. Under his leadership, that office has undertaken significant evaluations on Medicare program integrity issues. The evaluations have resulted in billions of dollars in savings to both the program and its beneficiaries. He has testified before various congressional committees and has earned numerous HHS and OIG awards for achievement. Mr. Vito received a B.A. degree in Accounting from Villanova University in 1978.
