#### **Union County Biodiesel Company, LLC – Present from September, 2004**

UCBC was formed to produce biodiesel in an on-farm pilot testing facility. Once the technology was proven, new facilities were built in South Roxanna, IL and Newburgh, IN. Responsibilities include daily management and technical oversight.

#### **Sprague Engineering - Present from April, 1995**

Sprague Engineering was formed with my Father, W.R. Sprague, who is a registered Land Surveyor. The business's current focus is surveying, site development and consulting engineering.

Since Gray Construction was a design/build firm, my responsibilities included developing the project requirements with the customer, overseeing the proposal development, preparing the project cost estimate, reviewing the conceptual and final design for compliance with the project requirements, planning and scheduling the project execution, letting and awarding the subcontracts, assisting in the management of the construction, and installation of process systems and equipment. In total, I was directly responsible for more than 11 projects, worth over \$30 million and assisted in 2 project worth over \$65 million.
