We are writing to express our concern about the pending regulatory agenda of the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) in light of the recent election and upcoming transition.

Although the leadership of the CPSC will soon change, congressional oversight of the Commission will continue. Therefore, any action taken by the CPSC before a new chairman is designated will receive enhanced scrutiny. While we expect and encourage the Commission to continue its routine product safety enforcement on behalf of American consumers, we strongly encourage the CPSC to avoid focusing its attention and resources in the coming months on complex, partisan, or otherwise controversial items that the new Congress and new Administration will have an interest in reviewing.
