Amend section 8 to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 8. REPORT IDENTIFYING BEST PRACTICES FOR ES-**
2 **TABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF LOCAL**
3 **COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARDS.**

4 (a) BEST PRACTICES REPORT.—Not later than 18
5 months after the date of enactment of this Act, the Nu-
6 clear Regulatory Commission shall submit to Congress,
7 and make publicly available, a report identifying best prac-
8 tices with respect to the establishment and operation of
9 a local community advisory board to foster communication
10 and information exchange between a licensee planning for
11 and involved in decommissioning activities and members
12 of the community that decommissioning activities may af-
13 fect, including lessons learned from any such board in ex-
14 istence before the date of enactment of this Act.

15 (b) CONTENTS.—The report described in subsection

16 (a) shall include—

17 (1) a description of—

18 (A) the topics that could be brought before
19 a local community advisory board;

1 (B) how such a board's input could be
2 used to inform the decision-making processes of
3 stakeholders for various decommissioning activi-
4 ties;

5 (C) what interaction such a board could
6 have with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission
7 and other Federal regulatory bodies to support
8 the board members' overall understanding of
9 the decommissioning process and promote dia-
10 logue between the affected stakeholders and the
11 licensee involved in decommissioning activities;
12 and

13 (D) how such a board could offer opportu-
14 nities for public engagement throughout all
15 phases of the decommissioning process;

16 (2) a discussion of the composition of a local
17 community advisory board; and

18 (3) best practices relating to the establishment
19 and operation of a local community advisory board,
20 including—

21 (A) the time of establishment of such a
22 board;

23 (B) the frequency of meetings of such a
24 board;

25 (C) the selection of board members;

1 (D) the term of board members;

2 (E) the responsibility for logistics required
3 to support such a board's meetings and other
4 routine activities; and

5 (F) any other best practices relating to
6 such a local community advisory board that are
7 identified by the Commission.

8 (c) CONSULTATION.—In developing the report de-
9 scribed in subsection (a), the Nuclear Regulatory Commis-
10 sion shall consult with any host State, any community
11 within the emergency planning zone of an applicable nu-
12 clear facility, and any existing local community advisory
13 board.
