3 (c) LEGISLATIVE CHANGES FURTHER DESCRIBED.—

4 The legislative changes referred to in paragraph (1)
5 should—

6 (1) provide the Food and Drug Administration
7 with greater information regarding cosmetic manu-
8 facturers;

9 (2) require that the safety of cosmetic products
10 can be verified;

11 (3) offer guidance on how cosmetics and per-
12 sonal care products should be safely manufactured;

13 (4) require timely reporting of serious adverse
14 events to the Food and Drug Administration; and

15 (5) provide the Food and Drug Administration
16 with the necessary resources to review cosmetic in-
17 gredients, increase staff capacity, and improve over-
18 sight over cosmetic imports.
