Dear Representatives,

On behalf of more than 2.8 million Americans for Prosperity activists in all 50 states, I write to you in support of a resolution disapproving of the Environmental Protection Agency's rule establishing Carbon Pollution Standards for New, Modified and Reconstructed Power Plants.

The President's misguided carbon rule will limit Americans access to affordable and reliable electricity by imposing onerous standards for new power plants – disproportionately harming lower income families. The rule effectively bans affordable electricity produced from coal and will hamstring economic growth and job creation.

American workers and small businesses continue to struggle, and bureaucratic red tape that restricts access to affordable and reliable energy will only make things more difficult.

Banning future development of coal power plants is not a decision that the President and his administration have the authority make unilaterally. The rule is yet another attempt by the President to advance an expensive environmental agenda so radical that he was unable to pass it through Congress even when his party controlled both chambers.

Americans for Prosperity is proud to support efforts to combat the attack on affordable and reliable electricity from the Obama administration, including Chairman Whitfield's H.J. Res. 71 and Congressman Ratcliffe's H.J. Res. 67. I urge you to support passage and I look forward to working with you in the future.
