NMA Applauds Bi-Partisan CRA to Restrain EPA's Unwanted Climate Plan

National Mining Association (NMA) President and CEO Hal Quinn issued the following statement today in support of efforts in both Houses to pass a Congressional Review Act resolution blocking the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Clean Power Plan:

“NMA applauds Republicans and Democrats in both chambers for supporting resolutions blocking EPA’s regulatory attempts to transform the nation’s power supply system in defiance of congressional intent.
