Urge Your Member to Repeal the President's Failed Healthcare Law

Dear Marty and Marjorie,

Tomorrow, the House of Representatives will vote to repeal the President's failed healthcare law, the first chance many new Members of Congress will have to stake out a formal position on Obamacare and bring the country one step closer to full repeal. Old or new, Democrat or Republican, every Member of Congress should vote for H.R. 596, a bill sponsored by Rep. Byrne (R-AL) that would repeal government-imposed healthcare and its conscience crushing mandates.

From the start, FRC has opposed Obamacare because of its threats to religious liberty, its funding of elective abortion and its march towards healthcare rationing.

These threats to religious freedom were exposed and vindicated in the Supreme Court's ruling in *Hobby Lobby*, a decision upholding the conscience rights of closely held corporations, but those same mandates are still enforceable against millions of other American's in situations similar, but not identical, to Hobby Lobby's, such as nonprofits.

Likewise, Obamacare subsidizes health plans that include coverage for elective abortion, and can even pay directly for elective abortion by bypassing the longstanding federal amendment blocking such spending. The law also mandates an abortion surcharge on all plan participants and will fund multi-state plans with elective abortion.

Finally, the law gives the Obama administration power to impose rationing measures if they are recommended by the unelected members of the Independent Payment Advisory Board. Such recommendations could even be used to limit the health care necessary in costly end-of-life settings.

Urge your Member of Congress to vote for H.R. 596, a bill to repeal Obamacare and move toward a patient-centered system that respects rights of conscience.
