

Entrust (including its wholly owned subsidiary Cygnacom Solutions Inc) has approximately \$100M in annual revenue. Total revenues from the US Government represented 13% and 15% of total revenues in the years ended December 31, 2009 and 2010, respectively (the data for the year ending 2011 is not yet available, but can be provided upon request). This data includes revenues sold through resellers to government end-users.
