All documents and communications referring or relating to any request from the Department of Health & Human Services (“HHS”) or any of its component agencies to the Office of Management & Budget (“OMB”) regarding the apportionment of appropriated funds related in any way to Basic Health Program (“BHP”) payments, including all supporting documentation and all prior drafts of apportionment requests.
3. All documents and communications referring or relating to OMB’s consideration and granting of any request for apportionment from HHS or any of its component agencies.
4. All documents and communications, including but not limited to any and all drafts, referring or relating to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Internal Revenue Service and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services supporting the payment of and accounting for BHP payments.
