


Pursuant to Rules X and XI of the U.S. House of Representatives, the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Energy and Commerce are investigating the Administration's implementation of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA), including the funding and implementation of the cost-sharing reduction (CSR) program created by the Act.

In recent transcribed interviews with Treasury officials, several officials described a legal memorandum drafted by the Office of Management and Budget regarding the funding of the CSR program. This memorandum was shared with several Treasury officials around January 2014. The Committees requested the document from both the Department of Treasury and the Department of Health and Human Services, but both departments have informed the Committees that they do not have a copy of the memorandum in their possession. The Committees request that OMB produce this legal memorandum by or before May 2, 2016.
