
ENROLLMENT DATA REQUEST UPDATE

Pursuant to Rules X and XI of the United States House of Representatives, the Committee on Energy and Commerce is examining the implementation of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

Thank you for your cooperation with the committee's March 13 request on enrollment data. Due to the administration's repeated delays and extensions we believe additional data is required to determine who has enrolled and paid for a plan on the Federally-Facilitated Marketplace. We request that your organization provide the committee with an update of the information requested on March 13 no later than May 20, 2014.




