
Dear Senator Manchin and Chairman Whitfield,

On behalf of America's Natural Gas Alliance ("ANGA") I write in support of "The Electricity Security and Affordability Act" (H.R. 3826/S. 1905). We share your view, however, that regulation should not mandate the installation or utilization of technology that is not commercially viable.
