Dear Brandon,

The House of Representatives will vote later today on passage of HR 4606, the Ensuring Small Scale LNG Certainty and Access Act, introduced by Rep. Bill Johnson (R-OH). HR 4606 will help the Department of Energy approve LNG export or import applications "without modification or delay" of up to 0.14 bcf per day if no environmental reviews are required. This improvement will reduce waiting times by several months and responsibly streamline the regulatory process and better leverage America's robust and growing LNG export market. U.S. LNG exports have been a tremendous boon to our economy, enhance our energy security and provide an important energy resource to our global partners.

API urges members of the House of Representatives to vote in favor of this bipartisan legislation later today and oppose harmful amendments. API opposes the DeGette Amendment and the Pallone Amendment, both of which will add unnecessary delays to a responsible permitting process.

Thank you for your support of Congressman Bill Johnson's H.R. 4606, Ensuring Small Scale LNG Certainty and Access Act.
